

Changes in the Dow Jones STOXX indexes

Zurich, July 2, 1998: STOXX Ltd. announces the following changes to the Dow Jones STOXX Indexes:

- Due to its delisting at the Milan stock exchange, the Italian industrial company SASIB (IT0000080488), has been deleted from the Dow Jones STOXX indexes, effective July 3, 1998.
- The German utility company RWE has converted some of its preference shares and all of its registered shares into ordinary shares. As a result, the number of ordinary shares for RWE (DE0007037004) will change from 330,358,900 to 473,012,047 effective July 7, 1998. The new number of shares will be used in the index calculation of the STOXX indexes from July 7, 1998 on. Based on today's figures, RWE's weighting in the Dow Jones EURO STOXX 50 index will increase to 1.64 % (from 1.15 %) and its weighting in the Dow Jones STOXX 50 index will increase to 1.13 % (from 0.79 %).
