



Changes to the Dow Jones STOXXSM Large, Broad & Bank Sector Indexes

Banca Intesa (IT) Increases Share Capital

➤ Increased Weightings: Banca Intesa (IT)

Zurich, December 30, 1999: STOXX Limited announces the following changes to the Dow Jones STOXXSM indexes:

The Italian bank Banca Intesa (IT0000072618) has increased its share capital to fund recent corporate actions.

- Banca Intesa's number of shares will increase from 2,568,112,640 to 4,641,059,700 shares necessitating changes to its weightings in all the relevant Dow Jones STOXXSM large, broad and bank sector indexes effective January 5, 2000*.

Banca Intesa's market capitalisation will increase from 10.5 BEUR to 19 BEUR effective January 5, 2000*.

Finmeccanica (IT) Merges with Microelettronica Italiana – MEI (IT)

➤ Increased Weightings: Finmeccanica (IT)

Zurich, December 30, 1999: STOXX Limited announces the following changes to the Dow Jones STOXXSM indexes:

The Italian technology company Finmeccanica (IT0001199840) will merge with the non-component Italian company Microelettronica Italiana – MEI to form the Italian technology company Finmeccanica (IT0001407847).

- Finmeccanica's number of shares will increase from 3,480,868,864 to 8,392,324,500 shares necessitating changes to its weightings in all the relevant Dow Jones STOXXSM mid, broad and technology sector indexes effective January 5, 2000*.

Finmeccanica's market capitalisation will increase from 4.4 BEUR to 10.6 BEUR effective January 5, 2000*.
